PRICE POINT EXAMPLES

One of the hardest parts of choosing your wedding flowers is working out how best to make your budget work and what it could potentially get you.

We love working with couples on an individual basis to discuss ways of maximising their budget, however, we have put some suggestions together based on our knowledge of how you can use various price points in different ways to make your floral dreams come to life on the big day.

Please keep in mind that there are often variables that come into play such as venue location, your personal style and aesthetic requests, quantities required and staffing needed to fulfil the design set-up and pack-down - Therefore these suggestions do not include GST or service fees.

We have a budget of \$1,000 - \$1,200

IDEA 1

- Bridal bouquet of en mass roses
- Groom buttonhole
- 2x Bridesmaids bouquets of roses en masse
- 2x Groomsmen buttonholes
- 1x Flowergirl bouquet
- 2x Father of the Bride/Groom buttonholes
- 2x Mother of the Bride/Groom wrist corsages.

IDEA 2

- Premium bridal bouquet with premium flowers and silk ribbons
- Groom buttonhole
- A stunning floral display on floral stands that can act as both a ceremony arbour and then be re-located to the reception as a bridal table feature.



We have a budget of \$1,500 - \$2,000

I D E A 1

- Signature bridal bouquet
- Groom buttonhole
- 3x Bridesmaids bouquets
- 3x Groomsmen buttonholes
- 2x Floral sprays on floral stands that can act as both a ceremony arbour and then be re-located to the reception as a bridal table feature
- 30x Bud vases to scatter down your reception tables.

I D E A 2

- Bridal bouquet of en mass roses
- Groom buttonhole
- Corner spray for an arbour
- Hanging feature installation for the reception.
- 10m of light coverage, flat-lay greenery for reception tables

We have a budget of \$2,500 - \$3,000

I D E A 1

- Signature bridal bouquet
- Groom buttonhole
- 4x Bridesmaids bouquets
- 4x Groomsmen buttonholes
- 1x Flowergirl bouquet
- Corner spray for an arbour
- 6x Small aisle arrangements that can be re-used in the reception on guests tables.

I D E A 2

- Premium bridal bouquet with premium flowers and silk ribbons
- Groom buttonhole
- 2x Bridesmaids bouquets of en mass roses
- 2x Groomsmen buttonholes
- Corner and accent arbour feature
- 2x Large aisle arrangements for the ceremony that can be moved into the reception
- Bridal table feature arrangement for the bride and groom
- 10x Cocktail arrangement for the guest tables.



We have a budget of \$3,500 - \$4,500

IDEA 1

- Premium bridal bouquet with premium flowers and silk ribbons
- Groom buttonhole
- 2x Bridesmaids bouquets
- 2x Groomsmen buttonholes
- 2x Flowergirl flower crowns and petal baskets

- 2x Hanging installation in the reception
- 10 small table arrangements for the reception tables
- 30x Budvases to scatter in between
- of flat lay greenery on guest tables and scattered tealight candles.

IDEA 3

- Premium bridal bouquet with premium flowers and silk ribbons
- Groom buttonhole
- 3x Bridesmaids bouquets
- 3x Groomsmen buttonholes.
- Corner spray for an arbour
- 5m Bridal table feature
- 1x Hanging installation in the reception
- 10m of flat lay greenery on guest tables and scattered tealight candles.

IDEA 2

- Signature bridal bouquet
- Groom buttonhole
- 4x Bridesmaids bouquets
- 4x Groomsmen buttonholes
- 1x Flowergirl bouquet
- 2x father of the Bride/Groom buttonholes
- 2x Mother of the Bride/Groom wrist corsages
- Corner and accent arbour feature
- Lanterns and candle arbour base styling which we can re-use in the reception,
- 8m Aisle greenery and rose petals
- 2x Aisle entry features which we can re-use in the reception
- 30x Petal cones for guests.
- 30x Bud vases for the reception tables.



We have a budget of \$5,500 - \$7,000

IDEA 1

- Premium bridal bouquet with premium flowers and silk ribbons
- Bridal hair flower pins
- Groom buttonhole
- 2x Premium Bridesmaids bouquets
- 2x Groomsmen buttonholes
- 2x Flowergirl bouquets
- 2 x Flowergirl hair flower pins
- 2x Urn arrangements for the ceremony entry that can be re-located to the reception entryway.
- Floral crescent instillation for the alter/ceremony space that can be moved to a photo-op area or bridal table.
- 4 x Hanging floral hoop installation in the reception or above the dance floor.
- 20 structured table arrangements for the reception tables
- 30x Budvases to scatter in between

IDEA 2

- Signature bridal bouquet
- Groom buttonhole
- 5x Bridesmaids bouquets
- 5x Groomsmen buttonholes
- 2x Flowergirl flower crowns and petal baskets
- 2x father of the Bride/Groom buttonholes
- 2x Mother of the Bride/Groom wrist corsages
- Church or ceremony entryway instillation
- Elaborate arbour feature
- Lanterns and candle arbour base styling which we can re-use in the reception,
- 8m Aisle greenery, rose petals and hurricane candles
- 30x Petal cones for guests.
- 12x Structured table arrangements for guest tables with scattered tealight candles.

IDEA 3

- Premium bridal bouquet with premium flowers and silk ribbons
- Groom buttonhole
- 3x Premium bridesmaids bouquets
- 3x Groomsmen buttonholes.
- 2x Elaborate floral sprays on floral stands that can act as both a ceremony arbour and then be re-located to the reception as a bridal table feature
- 5m Bridal table base feature with hurricane candles
- 2x Hanging installation in the reception
- 10m of flat lay greenery on guest tables with scattered bud vases and tealight candles
